Access and Security

Entry and exit to the camp site for cars is controlled by a barrier. You must report to reception on arrival to obtain an entry card (a deposit is required for this). The card must be touched on the panel at the barrier to obtain access. The barrier is locked after 11pm until morning. If you arrive back after 11, you may park your car in the lower car park (on the right as you enter) and walk up the hill to the caravan. You will need to return the entry card to the reception at the end of your stay to receive the deposit.

The key for the caravan is kept in a secure combination box near to the decking area. The location and number to unlock it will be supplied to you prior to your holiday. Please ensure you return the key at the end of your stay and lock the box.

Instructions about how to get to the caravan and other useful information may be downloaded from the website www.escapetotheriviera.co.uk.

Please secure the caravan when not occupied by closing the windows and locking the doors.

Use of the Caravan

All household items are provided for use by renters. You are welcome to use any food or consumables you find when you arrive, but please replace these before you leave for the next holiday maker. Kindly also replace any minor breakages or report more serious ones.

Please leave the caravan clean and tidy at the end of your stay with all items in their original position. The bedding should be left in place and will be washed upon your departure.

Rubbish must be deposited in the large bins by the gate at the entrance to the site. Please do not leave any in or around the caravan once you have departed. A large blue box is provided to store rubbish and recycling temporarily outside the caravan. There is also a small bin located under the sink for food waste.

You must agree to abide by the rules of the site; these are displayed by the reception. You are welcome to use the swimming pool, but please note that it is often not lifeguarded, especially out of season.

Please retract the gazebo if it is windy or when you go out, as if the wind gets up, it is likely to break off and fly away!

Use of gas appliances

Please take great care with the gas appliances, especially in a confined space. The cooker and gas fire must be lit with a match and to make the grill, oven or fire work, you must also hold the knob in for at least 30 seconds after lighting the gas, in order for the flame to stay on.

The water heater is located in the far right eye level cupboard in the kitchen area. It should already be on. If for some reason the pilot light is out (sometimes it is blown out by the Mistral), instructions for relighting may be found in the folder on the back of the door to the water heater cupboard. The appliances are inspected regularly for safety and the certificate may also be found in the folder.

Please check all the gas controls for the cooker are off before going to bed.

Electricity

The caravan has French mains electricity – adaptors are required to run UK appliances. Please note that the caravan operates on a relatively low power circuit breaker and is not suitable for appliances which heat up (apart from the kettle) or those which generally draw large amounts of current. Use of items such as hair dryers, or having many items on at once, will cause the switch to trip.
